Format

- Game: DominionExpansions Used: No
- Player Count: 4
- Round One Format: 3 Game Group Stage
- Deck Selection: Revealed on the day
- Tournament Special Rules
 - Player Order
 - For the first game of the group stage and EVERY other round player order will be determined randomly
 - For the second game of the group stage player order will shift 1 space
 - E.g The 1st player will become the 2nd player etc
 - Tie Breakers in priority
 - The player who took the fewer turns
 - E.g The game ends on Player 2s turn, which means Players 1 and 2 have had 1 extra turn compared to players 3 and 4
 - If tied players took the same amount of turns than group points will be shared

Rounds

Group Stage

- Group Size: 4 PlayersNumber of Games: 2
- Points Awarded
 - 1st: 8 Points2nd: 5 Points3rd: 3 Points4th: 1 Point
- Qualification Criteria
 - Players will qualify for the Quarter Finals in the following priority
 - Less 16 Groups
 - The Winner of each group + the highest ranked 2nd placed players based on a priority of;
 - o Groups Points Scored

- Combined Game Scores
- Sum of the percentage of victory points the players reached SEE EXAMPLE AT END OF RULES
- 16 Groups Exactly
 - The Winner of each group
- More than 16 Groups
 - The Winners of each group ranked by the following priority
 - Groups Points Scored
 - Combined Game Scores
 - Sum of the percentage of victory points the players reached SEE EXAMPLE AT END OF RULES

Quarter Finals

- Number of Tables: 4
- Group Size: 4
- Number of Games: 1
- Qualification Criteria
 - The 1st and 2nd placed player in each Quarter Final Game will advance to the Semi Finals
 - The player who took the fewer turns
 - E.g The game ends on Player 2s turn, which means Players 1 and 2 have had 1 extra turn compared to players 3 and 4
 - Sum of the percentage of victory points the players reached through both the Group Stage & Quarter Final SEE EXAMPLE AT END OF RULES

Semi Finals

- Number of Tables: 2
- Group Size: 4
- Number of Games: 1
- Qualification Criteria
 - The 1st and 2nd placed player in each Quarter Final Game will advance to the Semi Finals
 - The player who took the fewer turns
 - E.g The game ends on Player 2s turn, which means Players 1 and 2 have had 1 extra turn compared to players 3 and 4
 - Sum of the percentage of victory points the players reached through both the Group Stage, Quarter Final and Semi Final SEE EXAMPLE AT END OF RULES

Grand Final

- Number of Tables: 1
- Group Size: 4
- Number of Games: 1
- Qualification Criteria
 - The 1st and 2nd placed player in each Quarter Final Game will advance to the Semi Finals
 - The player who took the fewer turns
 - E.g The game ends on Player 2s turn, which means Players 1 and 2 have had 1 extra turn compared to players 3 and 4
 - Sum of the percentage of victory points the players reached through both the Group Stage, Quarter Final, Semi Final & Grand Final SEE
 EXAMPLE AT END OF RULES

Sum of the percentage of victory points example:

Example (after three rounds):

Players A and B both win 2 games.

Both get 28 victory points - so there is still a tie.

Now the percentages of victory points will be calculated.

Player A:

Game 1: A gets 10 VPs, there were 32 VPs at the table, so his percentage is: 31.25%.

Game 2: A gets 8 VPs, there were 30 VPs at the table, so his percentage is: 26.67%.

Game 3: A gets 10 VPs, there were 36 VPs at the table, so his percentage is: 27.78%.

Player A's total is: 85.70%.

Player B:

Game 1: B gets 10 VPs, there were 30 VPs at the table, so his percentage is: 33.33%.

Game 2: B gets 10 VPs, there were 33 VPs at the table, so his percentage is: 30.3%.

Game 3: B gets 8 VPs, there were 36 VPs at the table, so his percentage is: 22.22%.

Player B's total is: 85.85%.

Therefore player B is ranked higher than player A.
